# Grévin unveiled this June 25, Queen Marie-Antoinette, absolute icon and inspiration of Haute Couture, wearing a court dress by Julien Fournié

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Queen Marie-Antoinette entered the Grévin museum in 1889 for the centenary of the French Revolution, in rather disastrous settings: the royal family at the Temple, in 1792 or at the Conciergerie in 1793, still represented today during his trial on October 14, 1793 ...

The wax character now sits, in her splendor and her auspicious hours, in the sumptuous Grévin Cupola, an original setting created in 1882, all of carved rosewood paneling, enhanced with gold, marble and Venetian mosaics, which welcomed *Sarah Bernhard, Countess Greyfulhe* and the designer *Paul Poiret*, and which has become, since 2014, Grévin Fashion where we also find *Gabrielle Chanel, Jean Paul Gaultier, Naomi Campbell, Coco Rocha, Cara Delevingne...* 

Since 2023, Grévin has given carte blanche to the great French fashion designer Julien Fournié to dress and enhance the characters of Audrey Fleurot, Penelope Cruz, Monica Bellucci, Angelina Jolie....

Julien Fournié embodies the perfect alliance between tradition and innovation in the world of Haute Couture.

Magician of cut and look, **Julien Fournié** likes to create characters to highlight the personality of his clients, drawing inspiration from the world around him, mixing artistic and cultural influences and technological to create pieces that transcend the boundaries of time and space.

Fashion at the Grévin Museum is a celebration of this great art and individual expression through the ages. It is a vibrant tribute to fashion designers, icons and all those who have helped shape the glittering world of fashion, inviting each visitor to immerse themselves in a story of passion, innovation and a magnetic charm.
